**BLUEBELT PROGRAM**

**DATE:** Thursday, July 8, 2010

**TIME & PLACE:** 10:00 AM - Meet at St. Andrew's Church Parking Lot - 40 Old Mill Rd. Staten Island. Will return to Parking Lot at approximately 12:30 PM.

**COST:** The event is provided courtesy of the NYC DEP at *no cost* to the Chapters.

**TRANSPORTATION:** Attendees will meet in the Church Parking Lot, then carpool in private vehicles to the other sites on the route.

**AGENDA:** To control storm water discharges, NYC DEP has undertaken a major capital program to build special Bluebelt facilities where the storm sewers end and the natural areas begin. These facilities, known as Best Management Practices (BMPs), minimize the negative impacts of storm water sewer discharges on those natural areas. BMPs that we will visit include constructed wetlands, storm water detention ponds, and stream restoration projects within the Richmond Creek Bluebelt. **LUNCH:** Please pack a lunch. We will conclude the tour at a picnic area in historic Richmondtown, a picturesque restoration village adjacent to Richmond Creek.

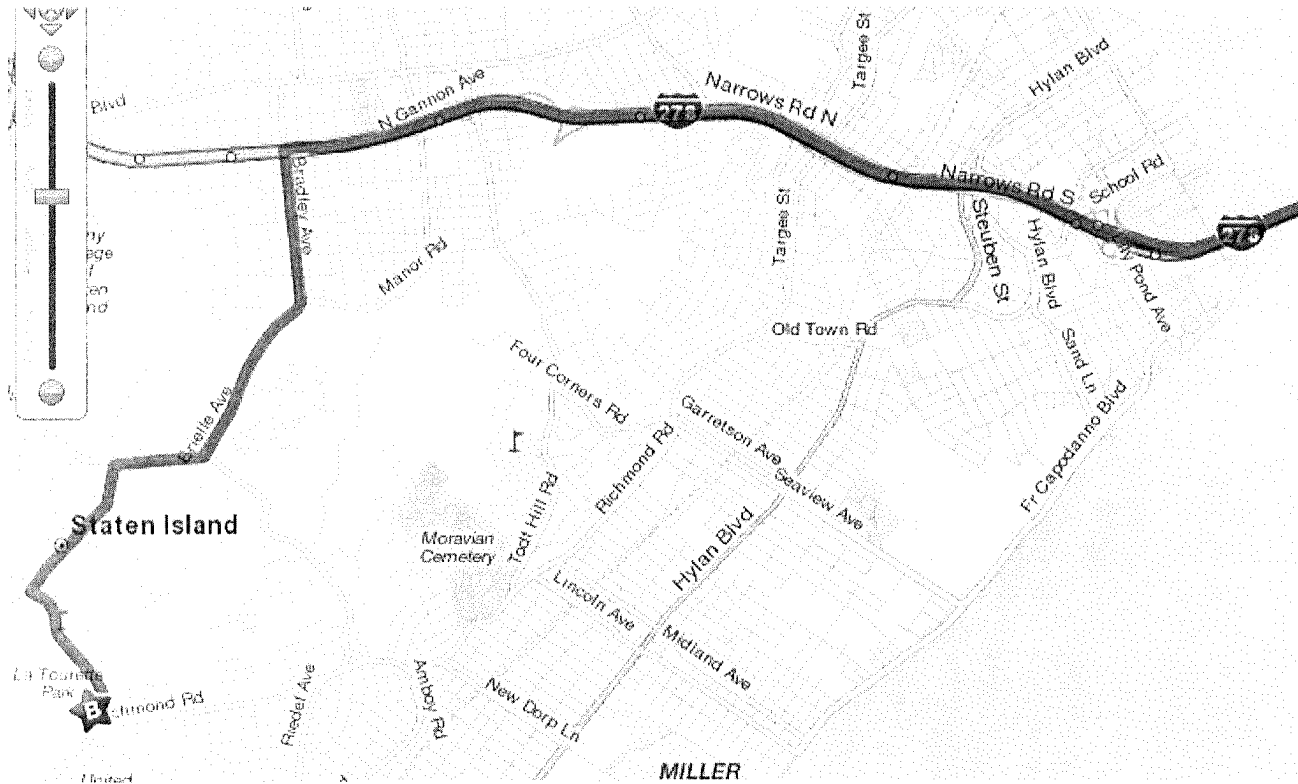

## **BY CAR**

Verrazano Bridge to Staten Island Expressway to Exit 11 Bradley Avenue. Turn left on Bradley Avenue for 0.7 mi. Bear right on Brielle Avenue for 0.8 mi. Turn right on Rockland Avenue for 0.4 mi. Turn left on Forest Hill Road for 0.7 mi. Turn left on Richmond Hill Road for 0.6 mi. The Church is on the right at the base of Richmond Hill Road. The parking lot entrance is on the left side of Richmond Hill Road immediately past the church.



## **BY PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION**

### **FROM THE STATEN ISLAND FERRY:**

Take the S74 bus from the terminal to Richmond Road and St. Patrick's Place.

### **BY BUS FROM BROOKLYN:**

S79 at 4TH Avenue and 86th Street to Clove Road/Targee Street. Walk one block to Richmond Road, and transfer to the S74. Take the S74 to St. Patrick's Place..
